POLICY STATEMENT

Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974

This is the Health and Safety Policy Statement of **The GreenHouse**

The GreenHouse is the home of SBC YouthWorks, the youth work of Stopsley Baptist Church, and GreenHouse Mentoring

SBC YouthWorks and GreenHouse Mentoring accept the responsibility of the health and safety of employees and volunteers working at the GreenHouse, and intend to provide adequate resources to identify, eliminate or control hazards at the workplace; monitor the application of this policy; revise this policy when necessary; and safeguard those who may be affected by the work processes within the GreenHouse.

Our statement of general policy is:

- to provide adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from work activities;
- to consult with our employees and volunteers on matters affecting their health and safety;
- to provide and maintain safe equipment;
- to ensure safe handling and use of substances;
- to provide information, instruction and supervision for employees and volunteers;
- to ensure all employees and volunteers are competent to do their tasks, and to give them adequate training;
- to prevent accidents and cases of work-related ill health;
- to maintain safe and healthy working conditions; and
- to review and revise this policy as necessary at regular intervals.
